

For each level, you will need to meet MOST of the requirements. You can talk to your teacher about areas you excel at or areas you can improve.

LEVEL	REQUIREMENTS
<b>E</b>	<p>In general, students who show EXEMPLARY skills are</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Always on time to class</li> <li>• Has materials for class every time</li> <li>• Complete assigned work</li> <li>• Always on task and pays attention</li> <li>• Participates in class and group work</li> <li>• Listens and responds appropriately during class</li> <li>• Consistently respects rights of others in both actions and words</li> <li>• Follows classroom and school rules</li> <li>• Does the right thing!</li> </ul> <p>An EXEMPLARY student ALWAYS does the right thing, is a model school citizen, and a good example for others to follow.</p>
<b>P</b>	<p>In general, students who show PROFICIENT skills are</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only late to class on a rare occasion</li> <li>• Has materials for class, rarely needs to go to locker or borrow basic supplies</li> <li>• Completes most assignments on time</li> <li>• Normally on task and pays attention, quickly responds if redirected</li> <li>• Participates in class and group work, asks and answers questions, listens when appropriate</li> <li>• Usually respects others in both actions and words</li> <li>• Follows classroom and school rules, quickly responds when redirected</li> </ul> <p>A PROFICIENT student USUALLY does the right thing at school and responds appropriately if given a direction by an adult and with other students.</p>
<b>D</b>	<p>In general, students who show DEVELOPING skills are</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Often late to class</li> <li>• Rarely comes to class prepared, often has to ask to go to locker or borrow basic supplies</li> <li>• Completes some assignments on time, has late and missing work</li> <li>• Occasionally on task, has to be reminded of expectations</li> <li>• Pays attention in class and during group work some of the time, can be a distraction to others</li> <li>• Sometimes respects others in both actions and words</li> <li>• Follows classroom and school rules, but needs a lot of reminders to do the right thing</li> </ul> <p>A DEVELOPING student tries to do the right thing, but needs reminders of the expectations on a regular basis</p>
<b>I</b>	<p>In general, students who show INSUFFICIENT skills are</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Consistently late to class</li> <li>• Does not come to class prepared, has to ask to go to locker or borrow basic supplies regularly</li> <li>• Completes some assignments on time, has late and missing work</li> <li>• Rarely on task, consistently has to be reminded of expectations</li> <li>• Rarely pays attention, often can be a distraction to others</li> <li>• Rarely respects others</li> </ul> <p>AN INSUFFICIENT student needs reminders of the expectations on a regular basis</p>
