We are asking that parents/guardians and players read and follow the guidelines below in order to make it the most successful season possible.

- A completed physical and concussion form are required for all sports
- Come to all practices. If you must miss please let the coaches know beforehand whenever possible. 3 or more unexcused absences can result in dismissal from the team and equipment to be turned in.
- Practices start right after school at 2:50 and end between 5:00-5:30. Please have your child picked up then. There will be no practice after school on Fridays due to the new district schedule.
- Being an athlete is a privilege, be sure to take care of academics in the classroom and be sure to be a positive role model outside of practice. Behavior at school or on school grounds CAN exclude you from games.
- Parents are asked to allow their student-athletes to focus on practice by meeting them after practice has concluded; any questions you have as a parent may be asked through email or by phone.
- You may ride back to Wilson on the bus or you may ride home with your parents. If you are riding home with your parents a coach needs to see your parent before you leave. You will not go home with friends parents unless the office has been contacted!
